

Application A1216 Food derived from herbicide-tolerant canola line MON94100 1st Call for submissions paper

Submission

The NSW Food Authority (NSWFA) welcomes the opportunity to comment on the 1st call for submissions on Application A1216 – Food derived from herbicide-tolerant canola line MON94100.

NSW supports the novel and collaborative approach of FSANZ in conducting the safety risk assessment for this Application. The sharing of risk assessment data and resources between international regulators (FSANZ and Health Canada) for mutual benefit is supported.

NSW further appreciates FSANZ transparency in ensuring that processes as required in the FSANZ Applications handbook for GM applications are followed for A1216 to the same degree as they would have had to be if FSANZ undertaken the same work itself. This is evidenced in SD 2 of the 1st CFS. NSW supports application of this approach to future collaborative projects to ensure the same risk assessment outcome is obtained regardless whether FSANZ or Health Canada undertakes the work.

NSW does not have any concerns to raise to FSANZ attention with this Application.
